Historical Concessional Registration Scheme (HCRS) Rules and Regulations Monday, 22 September 2008

These rules and regulations must be read in conjunction with the current ACT Council of Motor Clubs Guidelines.

These are the Club VeeDub (Canberra Chapter) HCRS rules in addition to the above guidelines.

1. You **must attend at least 3 club events**, of which Shannons Autofest is compulsory. (You only need to bring one of your HCRS vehicles if you have more than one.)
2. You must be an active member for at least six months before you will be eligible to apply for your vehicle to be registered under HCRS. Thereafter you must remain an active member of the club by attending meetings, club outings and any other club organised events.
3. You must notify the date that the registration becomes effective and when it ceases to be effective. This may be by email.
4. You must notify to the Registrar any changes in the information contained on the historical registration application form. This may be by email.
5. Inspection of the vehicle by the Registrar is required before an application form is signed.
6. No modifications to the vehicle are permitted without notification and approval of the Registrar.
