Come along, support the club, meet new people, buy some stuff, and see some great cars!


June 27 is our Pub run to Collector, we need final numbers ASAP to book.





Many model assembly kits produced in the 70's and 80's featured VW's and these days are still highly sought after by collectors particularly if they are still unassembled and the boxes are in mint condition, brands such as Monogram and Revell come to mind.

However if you have the need to use some glue practically on the perplex windows, remember the golden rule, use only diluted PVA wood glue as





this dries clear, excess can be easily wiped off and will not affect the plastic.


With the release of popular Bay window buses in recently times some brands can be very expensive and these examples here are mostly likely the next best alternative at a fraction of the price.





Club VW Supersprint

Giving it a go

So you've decided to run in the Club VW Supersprint. What do you need to do? There are 2 prerequisite pieces of paperwork required. First and foremost you will need to be a member of a CAMS affiliated car club. If you are a member of Club VW Sydney then you're all set. If not membership of Club VW costs \$45 for 12 months. If you don't own a Volkswagen you will need to locate another club with CAMS affiliation. You can find these on the cams website www.cams.com.au and follow the sport -> club zone menu options.

The second crucial piece of paperwork is your CAMS level 2 speed licence, commonly known as an L2S. The \$100 L2S is a licence which allows you to run in all CAMS sanctioned "speed events" including khanacross, motorkhana, hillclimbs and supersprints. All of the entry level event formats. The licence doesn't involve a driving test or doctors medical exam. You only need to fill in a form, which contains a medical declaration. Basically this licence is just an insurance policy. It covers death, permanent or temporary disablement, ambulance costs, confinement to bed, emergency home help, funeral expenses, modification and rehabilitation... not cars. Allow plenty of time for CAMS to turn your licence application around. As a last resort, you can pay for your licence on the morning of the event.

Event Paperwork

Fill out the event paperwork ie entry form and scrutineering form. This will be fairly straight forward however I'll give a brief explanation of the vehicle categories. The CAMS NSW Supersprint Panel sets guidelines for vehicle classes. http://supersprints.com.au/rules-and-regulations/2010% 20Vehicle%20Regs.pdf. Club VW will be running under slightly modified versions of these rules.

Type 1 & 2 vehicles are for slightly modified registered Production Cars (excluding Four Wheel Drive Turbos, Clubmans, Kit Cars and Replicas), The only modifications allowed are safety and cosmetic items so long as they don't increase performance. You can change the driver's seat, you can fit a strut brace or sway bars. Wheels can be altered, by up to one inch in width and two inches in diameter. You can change carbs provided you have the same number of venturis as standard. ie you cant put twin carbs or a single twin throat carb onto a beetle. You can put dual kadrons on a type 3 or type 4 engine, but not idfs. Specifically, it has to be an original type engine, you cant increase displacement, or fit fibreglass panels. non factory

turbos or fuel injection is not allowed. A 1962 beetle cannot run in this class even if it has a 100% stock 1600 engine.

Type 3 is for modified cars. Any sized wheel and tyre is allowed so long as it doesn't protrude outside of standard guards. Any modification to engine is allowed. The engine can be replaced so long as it is from the same manufacturer and same configuration. Specifically you can fit a type 4 engine to a bug but not a Subaru. Still no fibreglass allowed.

Type 4 is generally reserved for purpose built race cars. Almost anything goes here. You can fit perspex windows, fibreglass panels, any engine and gearbox combination and suspension modification.

Type 5 is for open wheel race cars such as formula vee, offroad buggies (or anything that doesn't fit into another class)

Type SV is intended for all Road Registered vehicles including Clubmans, Kit Cars, Replicas and those vehicles having modifications in excess of that allowed in Types 1 and 2. This also includes 4wd turbocharged cars regardless of modifications. We will be allowing treaded racing tyres in this class, but no slicks.

Fill in all details on the entry form, fill in the top section of the scrutineering form, and sign the disclaimer. Mail it all off to PO Box 4069 Shellharbour with your payment and you're in.

Preparing the car.pre race day

If your car has 4 inflated tyres on it, then there is a class you can slot into. You don't need to make any excessive modifications. First thing you need to do is remove all the loose items from the car including what's in the glovebox. Take out all the rubbish, your CD's, remove the tissues, toys and hat from the back parcel shelf. Anything that can fly around the cabin needs to be removed. You can remove the spare tyre to shed some weight, though some people with beetles, type 3's may prefer to leave their spare in to add extra crash protection in

the event of an unlikely but possible "oops".

Next, you should do a little bit of maintenance. If you have one of those slight oil leaks that affects our brand, give the engine a degrease. Do your engine tune, valve adjustments. Make sure your brakes are in top condition, adjust and bleed them, make sure you have plenty of pad/ shoe material. Give each of the road wheels a jiggle and if necessary adjust wheel bearings. Your steering needs to be nice n tight. Your seat belts will need to in good condition. Battery needs to be secure and covered (preferably in a box) No fuel lines can pass through the cabin. Make sure the throttle returns freely. Return springs need to be attached to the throttle shaft itself... if its attached to a linkage and a linkage falls off... your in trouble. So do everything you would need to do for a rego check.

You will need to fit a fire extinguisher. A minimum 900g fire extinguisher which complies with AS1841 is required. Technically speaking, the mounting bracket needs to withstand a 25G impact. For a 900g extinguisher this means the bracket needs to hold 22kg. I don't know how you are expected to measure this, but common sense says that if the bracket looks barely capable of holding the extinguisher to a kitchen wall, you don't want it in your car whether your racing or not. 1kg of solid steel hurtling through the car during a crash is going to hurt.


You'll need a secondary method of securing the bonnet. This can be bonnet pins, a leather belt, rope, anything that will stop the bonnet from attempting to fold back over your roof should the regular latch mechanism fail. For beetles, you can tie from the bonnet handle to the front bumper. Other cars may be able to tie for a cross member. If your car is road registered, so long as you take all reasonable steps, this will be OK. You aren't expected to drill holes or anything silly.

In that empty glovebox, place a roll of blue electrical tape.

Decide what your race clothing will be. A proper race suit is preferable and safer, but minimum requirements consist of full length pants and shirt of non flammable material. Drill pants or jeans is OK. Cotton/flanno with long sleeves is OK for a shirt. Cotton socks/leather shoes. Gloves are not required in enclosed cars. Nylon is expressly forbidden for any part of your clothing. You'll also need a helmet that is marked with AS1698 sticker.

Race Day!


The big day has arrived. Get to the track early, at 7am. Make sure you haven't had too much to drink the night before. You may be breath tested and will not be allowed to run! There are plenty of



pits available at no cost. Select one and offload any tools and equipment you may have. If you have hubcaps, you need to remove them.

If crash rescue need to isolate the battery, they need to know where it is. Using the blue tape create a blue triangle on the outside bodywork adjacent to your battery. The triangle needs to be approx 15 cm along the sides. Cover all forward facing glass other than the windscreen. You can use your blue tape again or contact schoolbook covering. Anything that will collect the glass should you have a breakage. Any glass headlights, spotlights etc need to be covered. The third possible use for your tape is your race number. You need to put your race number on both sides of your car and also the top of the windscreen on left hand side of the car is useful.


Once your car is fully prepped, take your licence, club membership card, and race clothing down to scrutineering. The scrutineering bay is on the immediate left as you drive in the front gate. Officials in the shed will check off your particulars. If you don't have a your CAMS licence or cams affiliated club membership card you will not be permitted to race. Don't forget them! They are equally as important as your keys. If everything checks out OK, you will be given an armband to be placed on your right wrist and a scrutineering

sticker to go on top of your windscreen right hand side. The scrutineer will check over your car and you are free to take your car back to the pits and wait for the drivers' briefing. While waiting, pick up your electronic timing transponder, from the control tower & sign for it. This will be mounted on your car with cable ties. No big deal. Attendance at drivers' briefing is compulsory; you will need to sign in.

Racing

Wakefield Park is widely regarded as the best compact circuit in Australia – by drivers for its exhilarating straights and turns - and by spectators because friends can easily see all of the action, across the entire track, all of the time. This unique feature, plus the absence of trackside obstructions, also helps make the 2.2 km motor racing circuit among the safest in Australia. You're about to have the time of your life

All drivers will have been assigned a colour group which matches cars expecting to be approximately equal in speeds. You'll need to keep an ear out for the call to your group. When called make your way to your car and bring it to the dummy grid area. From here a marshal will call you specifically onto pit lane. 10 pairs will be called up.. Nerves will build, but there's no turning back now.



You're anxious for the starter to wave you onto the track. Finally pairs are being let out with about 10 seconds gap between them. You're away.

Timing doesn't start until you get back around to the start line. You aren't driving flat out just yet, probably about 80%. You're trying to memorise the corners and pick your driving line. Coming down the back straight for the first time you take some deep breaths as your first hot lap is about to start. A hot lap at Wakefield begins with a good exit coming onto the 900m main straight. So you enter the corner slow (relatively) in 2nd gear and exit fast, with the right foot buried through the floor. You're in 3rd before you know it, and in top gear before about half way along. The start line whizzes by, your transponder has crossed the wire beneath the track which has triggered the timing in the control tower. Its all for real now. You see the right hand bend at the end of the straight and wonder if you should go through flat out. Preoccupied with this dilemma you are too far to the right of the track. You need to be on the outside of corner 1 otherwise you are making the already tight turn 2 even tighter. You hit the brakes too early anyway, turn in way to early. Make mental note "wide turn 1, late turn 2".

After turn 2 the track heads uphill. It gets narrower which gives a heightened sense of speed. Left hand turn 3 is taken flat out by many. You float the car across the corner touching the ripple strip, absolutely nail it. You try to repeat this on the right hand turn 4, but it is tighter, and switches down hill. You have a little "moment" This turn 4 moment seems to join turns 4 & 5 together. You leave turn 5 feeling you should have done more. Turn 6 is exciting. It leads onto an "almost straight". You blast out of here but see the road is fast running out. Bravely you power on because to lift off here could see the cars rear end heading down the track first!

You nail the brake pedal on the approach to turn 8, the slowest corner of the track (at entry). It's not a tragic loss if you out brake yourself here as the corner is quite wide. You wind off steering lock and wind on power as the corner opens up. You've actually covered 8/10 of the corners at half track distance. From here on its all about power. Float the car across turn 9 and carry as much speed onto the back straight as possible. Its hard on the gas until your bravery runs out and you brake for turn 10. Its a tricky bugger. You head out wide at first, turn in late. Its a drag race to the finish line. Shift to 3rd, shift to 4th crossing the start finish line. That's 1 of 4 flying laps down. Time to take a quick breath just before that turn one. Do you go flat out or back off????????


